## Secondary I & II Program

### Course Objectives

- To enable students to create, perform and appreciate dramatic works.
- The drama program is designed to engage students on an emotional, physical, social and cultural level.
- The students will be engaging in activities such as trust, listening, voice, movement, characterization, story, improvisation, stage tactics as well as certain dramatic projects.

### Homework

- Journal entries are assigned once a cycle. Entries should be a half a page single spaced in length.
- Additional assignments or exercises may also be given.

### Evaluation

Evaluation for each term will be based on the following:

To create dramatic works	Uses ideas, elements of language, technique and organizational skills to create daily activities, exercises and assignments
To perform dramatic works	Expresses him/herself in front of an audience, listens to others, on task, works diligently, follows directions, and encourages others
To appreciate works	Analyzes and interprets the work of themselves and their peers through written journal entries and in-class comments

Drama is a practical course and full participation is expected. Students must take responsibility to make up for missed presentations and must work with the teacher to arrange time for missed work.
