Contract: Student Expectations

To ensure their continued participation in the Westwood Jr. Matrix Program students must meet or exceed the following expectations.

- Act in accordance to the Westwood Junior Code of Conduct
- Participate in all Enrichment Program Activities.
- Maintain a minimum 75% summative average in each of the Matrix Program subjects: English, Mathematics, Science, Science Humaines, and Matrix French (Group 31)
- Achieve at least (70%) in all subjects in each term, no failures in any subject permitted.
- Follow the Acceptable Use Policy for computer use as well as, maintain a positive behavior and a cooperative attitude in **all** classes.
- Perform a minimum of 10 hours of authorized community service during each school year and participate in at least one school life, or sport activity each school year.
 - o Perform at least two hours of community service per term.
 - o Community service must be at least three separate activities.
 - o Community service/School Life Log Book must be kept up to date for each term; completed Log Book to be handed in no later than **May 1st**.

Failure to meet any of these expectations will result in the student meeting with their teachers and their parents.

A student may be transferred out of the Matrix Program if it is evaluated that the student is not able to fulfill the expectations of the program.

Students who receive a suspension due to their involvement with drugs or alcohol will be permanently removed from the Matrix program.
