Contract: Student Expectations

To ensure their continued participation in the Westwood Jr. Matrix Program students must meet or exceed the following expectations.

- Participate in all Enrichment Program Activities.
- Maintain a minimum 75% summative average in each of the Matrix Program subjects: English, Mathematics, Science, Science Humaines, and French.
- Achieve at least (70%) in all subjects in each term, no failures in any subject permitted.
- Follow the Acceptable Use Policy for computer use.
- Maintain positive behavior and a cooperative attitude in all classes.
- Continue the positive behaviour and cooperative attitude in all areas of the school.
- Perform a minimum of 10 hours of authorized community service during each school year and participate in at least one school life, or sport activity each school year.
 - Perform at least two hours of community service per term.
 - Community service must be at least three separate activities.
 - Community service/School Life Logbook must be kept up to date for each term. It will be checked at the end of each term. The completed Logbook will be handed in no later than May 1st.

Failure to meet any of these expectations will result in a warning letter to students and their parents at the end of the closest term and possibly being transferred out of the Matrix Program.

Students who are suspended for disciplinary consequences due to involvement with drugs or alcohol, will be asked to leave the Matrix program.
